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CHAPTER 1 — AGNIPATH SCHEME & NOTIFICATION OVERVIEW

What is the Agnipath Scheme?

The Agnipath Scheme is India's transformative short-service defence recruitment model introduced in June 2022 by the Ministry of Defence. Recruits under this scheme are called Agniveers and serve for a fixed 4-year period in the Indian Army, Navy, or Air Force. After 4 years, up to 25% of each batch may be offered permanent enrolment as Regular Cadre Sailors, while the remaining 75% exit with the Seva Nidhi corpus and transferable skills.

Key Highlights of Agnipath Scheme

- 4-year fixed engagement period — all Agniveers serve exactly 4 years
- Up to 25% offered permanent enrolment based on performance and Navy requirement
- Monthly salary: Rs.30,000 (Year 1) rising to Rs.40,000 (Year 4)
- Tax-free Seva Nidhi corpus of approx. Rs.11.71 Lakh on exit after 4 years
- Training at INS Chilka, Odisha — premier naval training establishment
- No pension or gratuity for those exiting after 4 years
- Priority hiring in CISF, CRPF, BSF, ITBP, SSB for ex-Agniveers
- Agniveers CANNOT marry during the entire 4-year service period — violation = dismissal
- Enrolled under the Navy Act 1957

Physical Fitness Test (PFT) — Stage II Requirements

PFT is QUALIFYING only. You must pass PFT to proceed to the Stage II written exam and final merit.

Tip: PFT Preparation — Start from Day 1

Most candidates who fail Navy selection do so at PFT, not the written exam. Start running 1.6 km EVERY DAY from your first day of preparation. Target: complete in under 6 minutes before exam day (not 6:30 — aim better). Do 30 push-ups, 30 sit-ups, and 30 squats daily. Build to 50 each within 4 weeks. Combine physical and academic preparation from Day 1.

Medical Standards — Key Requirements

Medical Fitness — What is Checked

- Good physical and mental health — free from any disease or disability
- No colour blindness — disqualifying for most technical trades in Navy
- Normal hearing in both ears
- No flat feet (pes planus) or significant knock knees (genu valgum)
- No history of epilepsy or psychiatric disorders
- No significant orthopaedic conditions
- Normal BP, heart rate, lung function, blood tests (Hb, sugar)
- Dental fitness — adequate healthy teeth
- BMI within acceptable Navy range for your height
- No skin diseases that may affect duty performance

Important: Tattoos on visible areas (face, neck, forearms, hands) may cause disqualification. Do NOT apply mehendi/henna on hands before medical. Report as you are — no cosmetic alterations.

- Never skip English even if you prefer Hindi medium — 25 marks on the line

Mathematics (Target: 18+/25)

Mathematics Preparation Strategy

- Start with Class 11: Trigonometry, Sequences & Series, Coordinate Geometry
- Class 12 must-cover: Matrices, Integrals, Vectors, 3D Geometry, Probability
- Make a formula sheet — revise every night before sleeping
- High frequency topics: Probability, Trigonometry, Vectors, Integration
- Practice mental calculation — build speed for simple arithmetic steps
- NCERT Class 11 and 12 textbooks are the primary source — cover them fully

Physics / Science (Target: 18+/25)

Physics Preparation Strategy

- NCERT Class 11 and 12 Physics is THE backbone — read every chapter, every example
- High priority: Waves, Optics (Ray + Wave), Electricity, Magnetism, Modern Physics
- Memorise key formulae — $F=ma$, $V=IR$, $KE=\frac{1}{2}mv^2$, $E=hf$, etc.
- Understand concepts rather than just memorising formulas — SSR tests application
- Solve NCERT exemplar problems and previous year SSR question papers
- Average 1-2 questions per chapter — covering all chapters gives maximum marks

GK Preparation Strategy — Most Scoring Section

Do's on INET Exam Day

- Carry valid Government Photo ID (Aadhaar preferred) + Admit Card printout
- Reach exam centre 60 minutes before reporting time
- Attempt GK first — fastest section, most scoring for most candidates
- Then attempt English, then Science, then Mathematics
- Use remaining time to recheck marked/doubtful answers
- Skip questions you have NO idea about — negative marking applies

Don'ts on Exam Day

- DON'T bring mobile phone, smartwatch, or any electronic device — immediate disqualification
- DON'T guess randomly with no elimination — lose 0.25 per wrong answer
- DON'T be nervous about PFT — if you've trained every day, you will pass
- DON'T apply mehendi on hands before medical examination
- DON'T register multiple times — permanent debarment from Navy recruitment

- 6 recent passport-size photographs
- Domicile Certificate (issued by state government)
- NCC Certificate (A/B/C grade) — if applicable, may give preference

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
